- Pray for FEMA Administrator William "Brock" Long, Texas Governor Greg Abbott, local mayors and county leaders, Executive Director of the Baptist General Convention of Texas David Hardage and Executive Director of the Southern Baptists of Texas Convention Jim Richards as they make important decisions left and right.
