



Associational BNF Ministry Consultant

Suggested Job Description

For Associations where she serves on the WMU Leadership Team

The Associational BNF (Baptist Nursing Fellowship) Consultant is responsible for planning, implementing, and evaluating medical missions work in the association. He or she should be an active member of Alabama Baptist Nursing Fellowship.

Specific Functions are:

1. Be knowledgeable about Baptist Nursing Fellowship & Parish Nursing.
2. Serve on the associational WMU leadership team to coordinate BNF work with areas of associational work and to maintain records and report accomplishments of BNF projects.
3. Provide basic and specialized training for churches who wish to implement a health and wellness ministry for their church. Promote state level training among the churches.
4. Consult with churches without BNF to communicate the benefits of BNF and to assist them in connecting with or beginning a BNF group in their Association.
5. Advise the churches of Alabama BNF mission projects and trips.
6. Maintain an up-to-date list of BNF leaders in the association.
7. Is the association's contact person for BNF with Alabama WMU.
8. Plan, conduct, and evaluate Associational BNF ministry projects. (Leaders from the churches should be encouraged to help plan, conduct and evaluate these projects.)
